PARABLE OF THE SOWER - MARK 4:1-20

I. PARABLES ARE GLIMPSSES INTO THE UNSEEN REALM THROUGH THE WINDOW OF THE SEEN.

A. MARK 4:1-9 - THIS PARABLE IS ALL ABOUT LISTENING.

- The only way to guarantee that a seed doesn't grow is to keep it in your pocket.

B. BE ATTRACTIVE

- Be attractive = Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control (Gal. 5:22-23)

II.. THE SOILS

A. THE FIRST SOIL

- It doesn't matter how satisfied you are in the world or hurt by it. How many mistakes you've made or deals you've done. God wants you!

D. THE SECOND SOIL

- The exchange that the Gospel offers is that you get Jesus' life instead of your own, not in addition to your own.
- Jesus provides what the world has promised but could never deliver.

E. THE THIRD SOIL

- *"If the Devil can't make you sin, he'll make you busy."*
- Cornelia "Corrie" ten Boom

1. You can't please everyone, but you can choose who you disappoint.
2. Ask someone who loves Jesus and you to check your blind spot.

E. THE FOURTH SOIL

- *Ask him to do the gardening, stay when it gets difficult, and he'll grow the fruit.*
